Calls of Interest

Offense: Burglary of a Building

Date: 01.11.12

Time: 0200 hours

Location: 500 blk West Bitters Road

Officers were dispatched to a business for alarm activation. Officers arrived at the business and observed a San Antonio Police Officer at the location with a male. The male had a large cut on his left forearm and was bleeding heavily. EMS was called to the location to treat the male. Officers immediately saw the front door glass to the business was shattered with glass all over the ground. There were numerous blood spatters outside the door as well as inside the door. Officers entered the business while SAPD stayed with the male. Officers followed the blood spatters throughout the interior of the business. The blood trails led to several interior business doors. There did not appear to be any forced entry to the interior doors. Officers returned to the front of the business at which time EMS arrived and treated the male for the cut on his arm. It was determined that the male had cut himself as he forced entry through the glass window. The male was placed under arrest and secured in the back of a patrol car. The crime scene was processed for evidence. The male was treated at the hospital for the cut on his arm and he was then booked into jail.

An officer was dispatched to a local business for a vehicle on fire in the parking lot. When the officer arrived, the fire had been put out by the vehicle owner but it was still smoldering. An officer was contacted by the manager of a local business. The manager reported a customer had purchased merchandise on 01/12/2012 using a check. The customer had written a check in the amount of \$1,420.00 toward the purchase. The manager reported that upon contacting the bank, it was found that the check was written on a closed account. The manager researched the customer's account history and found that the male had made several purchases at several different Discount Tire stores with a total of almost \$7,000. It was learned that the male used checks from the same closed account to make all of the purchases. An officer contacted a bank employee from where the checks were issued and confirmed the account had been closed for a long time. This case is under investigation.
