Offense: Burglary of a Building

An officer was called to a local church for a burglary. It appeared a window was broken to gain entry to the building. Three televisions were stolen. The officer collected evidence at the scene. This case is under investigation.

Offense: Possession of Marijuana

An officer observed a vehicle make a left hand turn at the intersection of Winding Way and South Tower Drive without signaling. As the officer followed the vehicle, he was able to confirm, via in car radar unit, that the vehicle was traveling 42 MPH in a 30 MPH zone. The

officer initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle. As the vehicle was coming to a stop, the officer observed the driver reaching towards the passenger seat. Contact was made with the male driver, who was informed of the reason for the stop. The male provided the officer with a Texas ID card and proof of financial responsibility. The officer began to detect the odor of marijuana emitting from the vehicle and asked the male if there was anything illegal in the car. The male said that there was a pipe located on the passenger seat. The officer had the male exit the vehicle where he was detained pending investigation. During a pat down of male, the officer located a baggie of marijuana in his front pocket. At that time the male was placed under arrest and placed in the back seat of the patrol car. A second officer arrived on scene and began the vehicle inventory. During the inventory of the vehicle, the officer located two digital scales with marijuana residue on them. The marijuana was tested and showed to be positive as marijuana. The vehicle was impounded and the male was transported back to HCVPD for processing. The male was cited for the drug paraphernalia and then booked at the San Antonio Magistrates Office. The officer resumed patrol.

Offense: Crash

Time: 1515 hours

Location: 14100 blk San Pedro

A male was exiting a local business in his truck. Upon his exit, he struck a female on the access road with his vehicle. The driver did not see the female in front of his truck because the business has a very steep driveway and the driver could not see over the hood of his truck. The female had fallen onto the street and suffered minor injuries. EMS was called but the female declined going to the hospital.
