Once stopped, the officer made contact with the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle. While speaking with the driver, a bottle of beer on the passenger side floorboard was seen spilling liquid onto the carpet. The officer asked the male for his driver's license and he stated he didn't have one, but he had an identification card. The officer asked for his identification card which he provided.
