Offense: Fire Call

Date: 02.25.13

Time: 1428 hours

Location: 14300 blk San Pedro

An officer was dispatched to listed location for a grass fire. When the officer arrived, she observed several grass fires on both sides of the access road and notified dispatch. The officer was assisted by two Constables who blocked and directed traffic. The officer drove near a local business and saw four live wires hanging to the ground and requested City Public Service to make the location. The officer made contact with the near-by businesses and evacuated the buildings due to the live wires arcing and hanging near the building's roof. SAFD arrived, put the grass fires out and stood by until CPS made location. CPS arrived and took care of the wires. The officers resumed patrol.

Offense: Assault Bodily Injury-Family

Location: 13800 blk San Pedro

A female arrived at City Hall to file an assault report. The female told the officer that she had just made a report with SAPD regarding the incident and at the end they realized that the offense occurred in Hill Country Village. The female reported she had traveled a local business to meet with her boyfriend who is employed at the business. During the course of their conversation, the male became agitated and took her phone in an attempt to delete information from the phone. The female then took his phone and placed it on passenger seat and demanded that he return her phone. The male grabbed the female's shoulders and shook her while demanding that she return

his phone. The male then reached across the female and tried to grab his phone from the passenger seat. While withdrawing his hand from the passenger area of the vehicle, he scratched the female across her chest. The male departed the location and returned to work while the female remained in her vehicle and spoke to her father on the phone. The male returned to her vehicle several times demanding that she stop ruining his life. Finally, both parties left the location. Officers photographed the victim's injuries. Both arms had bruising and redness as well as several small scratches. The victim also had three large scratches on her chest. The case is under investigation.

An officer obtained an arrest warrant for the male that assaulted his girlfriend in the report above. The HCV officer as well as the suspect's probation officer arrived at the suspect's place of employment and took him into custody. The suspect was transported to the HCVPD for processing. Upon completion, the male was booked into jail.

Offense: Driving While Intoxicated/Possession of Marijuana

Location: 100 blk Limestone Creek

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding. Immediately upon making contact with the driver, the officer could detect a heavy odor of marijuana and alcohol emitting from the vehicle. The officer told the male why he had been stopped and the male said he was lost. The officer saw that the driver's eyes were red and glassy in appearance and his speech was slurred as he answered questions. The officer obtained a driver's license and asked the driver if he had anything to drink. The male stated that he only had 2 drinks with the last being approximately 30 from the time that he had been stopped. A computer check showed the driver to be clear. A field sobriety test was done on the driver which he failed. He was placed under arrest for DWI. During the vehicle inventory, the officer found marijuana in the console of the vehicle. The driver was booked on both charges.
