Offense: Theft

An officer was dispatched for a theft report. Details of the call indicated a gym member had his wallet stolen from an unsecured locker. Upon arrival, contact was made with the male who reported he had arrived at the location to workout at approximately 1345 hours on this date. The male related upon his arrival, he proceeded to the men's locker room to secure his gym bag and clothing in the provided lockers. At approximately 1630 hours on this date, he returned to the locker room to collect his belongings and depart the location. Upon entering the locker room he observed his locker to be open, and began to exam if the contents of the locker were still intact. His gym bag and clothing were still in the locker, but discovered his wallet and a pad lock for the locker to be missing. The pad lock was inside the gym bag as he had forgotten to secure the locker prior to working out. His was wallet and contents had been stolen. An officer was dispatched for a theft report. Details of the call indicated a known individual had stolen some precious metal from a customer. Upon arrival, contact was made with the male

customer who related he had entered the store to purchase some musical equipment from the store and trade in some silver ingots and bar, along with a firearm, which he possessed. During the transaction, the silver items were placed on the counter near the register, while the firearm was placed behind the counter. As he was being helped by employees away from the register, another employee began to take a payment transaction at the register. After several minutes, the male related he walked back over to the same register to complete his transaction and noticed the silver items were gone. He questioned the employees about the items and no one was aware of the missing silver. An employee then went to review the store video, and discovered a known customer had grabbed the silver from the counter and left the location. The store manager provided the identity of the suspect as he is a regular customer. This case has been referred to HCVPD CID for further investigation.

Officers were executing a search warrant in reference to some previous burglaries. Upon making entry into the hotel room, contact was made with a female and her boyfriend. The two were lawfully detained and handcuffed for officer safety. It was explained that officers had a search warrant to search the room and the white van outside in the parking lot. A copy of the search warrant was given to the male. The hotel room was full of miscellaneous property and tools. The male admitted to having methamphetamine on the nightstand by the bed. A computer check showed the male to have 3 Bexar County warrants for Burglary and Enhanced Theft. The warrants were confirmed via Bexar County dispatch and the male was taken into custody. The female was clear of any county warrants and was released at the scene. A computer check of the white van that was the subject of the search warrant came back stolen. There was a black Harley Davidson motorcycle that was parked in front of the white van that was sharing a parking spot. The motorcycle also came back as stolen. The vehicles were impounded and the male was booked into jail.
