Offense: Damaged Property

An officer observed a damaged light pole in the parking lot of a local business. The light pole was severely bent and the glass globes had fallen onto the pavement, shattering the fixtures. It appears a vehicle had backed into the light pole. The damage did not appear to be recent (within the last few hours) as there was no damage observed to the vehicles parked near the location and attempts had been made to partially clean up the area. The officer contacted an employee of the business and informed them of the damage. The officer resumed patrol.

An officer was dispatched for an individual passed out in a vehicle. Upon arrival, the officer observed a female sitting in the driver's seat of the vehicle which was off of the roadway. The officer saw that the vehicle was sitting on top of a City of Hill Country Village sign. A witness told the officer that he observed the female traveling on West Avenue approaching West Bitters with the driver's side door opened and one leg stuck out the door. The witness reported that the female's torso was slumped toward the passenger side of the vehicle. The witness saw the vehicle rolling at approximately 2 MPH, through a red light at the intersection. As the vehicle crossed West Bitters it crashed into the previous mentioned sign. The officer attempted to talk to the female but it was difficult to get her attention and understand her. SAFD and EMS arrived on scene and rendered aide. It was determined that the female would be transported to the hospital for further treatment. The female's husband arrived on the scene and took possession of the vehicle. The officer notified HCV Public Works of the sign damage and resumed patrol.

An officer stopped a vehicle for a stop sign violation. The driver produced his insurance and driver's license. A computer check showed the license to be suspended. The driver was cited for the violations and was told he would not be driving on a suspended license. A second driver came and drove the vehicle away. The officer resumed patrol.
