An officer was dispatched to a residence in reference to suspicious noise. The resident reported that she heard a digging or scratching noise coming from behind a wall in her bathroom. The resident was "pretty sure" that the noise was being made by an animal getting into her wall, but wanted an officer to make sure that it was not a person trying to enter her home through the wall. After a thorough inspection of the roof from ground level and of any possible points of entry to the wall from both the exterior and interior of the home, it was determined that there was not a person attempting to make entry into the home. The resident was advised to contact a pest control company to address the possibility of an animal being inside the wall or home.
