Offense: Violation of State Vehicle Laws

Location: 100 blk Winding Way

An officer stopped a male driver after the license return on his vehicle showed his insurance had expired. The officer asked him for his current insurance and he stated he didn't have any. At that time, the officer asked him for his license. He provided an ID card issued from Guatemala. The driver stated he did not have a license. It was confirmed the male did not have valid insurance on his truck and did not have valid driver's license. The vehicle was impounded and the driver was cited for the violations.

An officer was dispatched to a restaurant in reference to theft of property. Upon arrival the complaint reported that within the past two nights several pieces of furniture were taken from the business's patio. An estimated value of \$600.00 was given by the complainant. No suspect information or evidence was obtained at the scene. Offense: Wanted Person/Possession of a Controlled Substance

An officer performed a vehicle stop that resulted with an arrest for active warrants. The vehicle was stopped for a moving violation. A female was found to have active warrants. The female's identification was confirmed and the warrants were confirmed with the Bexar County Dispatcher. Once confirmation was obtained the female was placed under arrest and searched by a female officer from HPPD. No contraband was found during search. The female was transported to the Magistrate's Office to be booked. While being searched by a female detention officer during the intake process, a plastic baggie containing what appeared to be Heroin was found underneath the female's right breast. The HCV officer was standing alongside the female when he observed the contraband being removed from her bra. The item was then seized and tested with a narcotic analysis reagent kit. The suspect item gave a positive reaction to the presence of heroin. The heroin weighed less than 1 gram. The seized narcotic was placed into evidence and stored at the Hill Country Village Police Department's secured evidence room. The female received an additional charge for Possession of a Controlled Substance.
