Offense: Suspicious Person

An officer was dispatched to a suspicious person call. Details of the call indicated a male wearing gray slacks and a striped shirt was walking in the area while holding his genitals. The caller felt the suspicious male subject may pose a threat to children in the area, returning home from school. The officer checked the surrounding area and was unable to locate any such male subject as described. The officer resumed patrol.

An officer received a phone call from a store manager who reported a theft had occurred at his business. The manager said a male had stolen two gaming consoles from the store and left in a black compact vehicle. The manager stated that the incident was observed by an employee and that the suspect was recorded on their surveillance equipment. The video showed the suspect take two black Sony Play Stations from their display counter and casually walked out of the store without purchasing the items. An employee observed the theft and followed the suspect to the parking lot. The employee said the suspect drove away in a black vehicle and she was able to obtain a license plate number. No other occupants were observed in the vehicle. The manager said the suspect has been known to visit the store on several occasions and believes he may have purchased or pawned items in the past. This case is under investigation.

An officer was dispatched to a business in reference to a suspicious person. The manager had found a male within the property's secured fencing, holding an aquarium. The manager said when she confronted the male; the male hurled the item over the fence and then proceeded to climb over the barrier. The aquarium shattered on the pavement belonging to the adjoining property. While watching the suspect's direction of travel, the manager notice he ran towards a white Ford 150 and red Honda parked at an adjoining business. Once the suspect ran past the vehicles, both vehicles followed him toward Taco Cabana. A moment later both cars sped onto US 281 southbound. The manager did not see the suspect enter either of the vehicles. No individual matching the description given was located within the area. The incident was captured on video. The property closes at 2100 hours and a manager's approval is required after normal business hours.
