An officer was conducting a business check in the area and observed a vehicle pulling out of the parking lot of a closed business. The officer pulled behind the vehicle and activated the emergency lights of the patrol car and pulled the vehicle over. The officer went to the driver side and obtained the driver's license. The officer observed the driver and the passenger were very nervous. The officer questioned them as to what they were doing at the business well after normal business hours. The driver replied "nothing". While the officer questioned the driver, several small green leafy objects were observed on the driver's sweatshirt. The objects appeared to be marijuana buds. The officer asked the passenger for his id, but he stated he didn't have one. The officer asked again what the subjects had been doing and they said a girl had picked them up and taken them to a bar, but since the passenger did not have an id, they were not allowed to go into the bar so she brought them back. The officer asked the owner of the vehicle, if there was anything illegal in the vehicle and he said no. The officer asked for consent to search the vehicle

and owner granted it. The officer found marijuana and the passenger said it belonged to him. The passenger said the driver was unaware he had the marijuana. The passenger was arrested and booked into jail and the driver was released.

Offense: Driving While Intoxicated/Possession of a Controlled Substance

Location: 100 blk South Tower Drive

An officer had arrested a male for Driving While Intoxicated. During the search of the driver, a cigarette box was removed from the front left pocket of the jeans the driver was wearing. Inside of the cigarette box was a balled up/folded cellophane wrapper containing a white powdery substance. The driver was asked what it was and he stated that he did not know. When asked if he used drugs, he replied no. The white powdery substance was field tested. The field test revealed a presumptive positive result for the presence of cocaine. The cocaine was secured as evidence and placed in the Evidence Room for safekeeping. The male was booked at the Magistrate's Office for Driving While Intoxicated and for Possession of a Controlled Substance.
