Offense: Burglary of a Building

An officer discovered that the rear door to a vacant office had been pried open. The officer made entry and cleared the building. No one was found inside the building. The business had vacated the building approximately two weeks earlier and all of their belonging had been removed by the owner. It appears that unknown individuals had cut large holes into the wall in order to gain access to the adjoining business which is a bank. The property manager estimated the damages to be approximately \$50,000. Photographs were taken of the damage and attached to the report. The manager made arrangements for the rear door to be secured.

While investigating the burglary of an adjoining business, an officer discovered that unknown individuals had cut holes through the wall of that business in order to gain access to the offices inside the bank. Once inside the bank the unknown individuals searched though the offices. The bank manager did not know if anything was actually missing at that time. Evidence was collected at the scene. Two drawer facings that had been pried off were taken to the police department where they were secured in the evidence room for further processing. The bank manager would later provide video of the burglary.
