Offense: Prowler

Location: 100 blk Cherokee Lane

An officer observed what appeared to an adult male standing near a window at a residence on Cherokee Lane. The suspect was in the southwest corner of the residence. As the officer got closer to the residence, the suspect ran west towards the back of the residence. The officer then heard several dogs barking in the rear of the residence. The officer notified Bexar County Dispatch of the incident. The suspect was standing near a 4 foot wall. The only part of his body the officer observed was from his chest up to his head. The area was dark except for a light coming from inside the residence where the suspect was standing. The officer only observed the suspect for only a few seconds. Extra officers arrived on the scene to assist. A searched of the area revealed negative results of the suspect(s). There were no signs of forced entry to the residence. The officer knocked on the front door and rang the doorbell for approximately 7 minutes. The officer was unable to make contact with anyone inside the residence. Officers resumed patrol.

Offense: Possession of a Controlled Substance

An officer performed a vehicle stop for a moving violation that resulted with an arrest for a narcotic violation. The officer asked the male driver if he anything illegal in his vehicle. The male told the officer he had a glass pipe used to smoke marijuana in the middle console. The officer asked with there was anything else in the vehicle. The male said that a friend of his left a pill bottle in the glove box and was not sure what it contained. After the male admitted to possessing drug paraphernalia he was detained in hand restraints and a vehicle search was conducted. During the vehicle search, one glass pipe (with marijuana residue), two plastic baggies with white residue of suspected narcotic, and two cut straws with white residue of a suspected narcotic were found in the vehicle's middle console. One pill bottle concealing a plastic bag of what appeared to be Methamphetamine was found in the vehicle's glove box. A field test was performed on the suspect and it showed to be positive for methamphetamine. The male was charged with possession of a controlled substance and his vehicle was towed.
