**Offense: Driving While Intoxicated**

A citizen stopped and approached an officer in a business parking lot. The citizen wanted to report she had been following a drunk driver for quite some time. The citizen reported the driver had hit a retaining wall on US 281 and the continued driving. The citizen pointed out the vehicle to the officer. The officer caught up to the vehicle that was travelling at a very slow speed. A traffic stop was conducted and the female driver exhibited signs of intoxication. The driver was arrested and booked into jail.

An officer was dispatched to a verbal disturbance between a customer and the manager of a business. The officer arrived and contacted the night manager. The manager reported there had been four females in the restaurant that were upset because an employee did not stir the coffee they had ordered. The manager further reported that one of the unidentified females was particularly upset. The unidentified female began yelling and using profanity. The manager stated that she felt threatened by the four females. One of them had thrown cups at the manager before leaving. Officer checked the area and the females were not found. The officer stood by for a little while in the event the females returned.

A female who attends an adult care facility called to report an altercation that had occurred between herself and the group facility manager. The female reported the group manager was threatening to hit her. Contact was made with the group manager who said the female caller was having more issues than normal due to some family problems. The group manager told the officer that the female was verbally abusive and had struck her on the arm. She said that she did not want to pursue criminal charges. The officer was able to calm the situation and both parties departed the area. The officer resumed patrol.

**Offense: Assist the Public**

An officer was dispatched to a local business for an alleged assault. The officer arrived and contacted a male who reported he was walking down San Pedro when two men came out of the drainage ditch and attacked him with what he believed to be a box cutter. During the conversation, the officer detected a strong odor of alcohol emitting from the male. The male said he decided to leave an unknown bar and walk home after having an argument with his girlfriend on his cell phone. When I asked if there were any injuries received during the assault, the male revealed a small laceration to his right pinky finger. While attempting to obtain further information, the male recanted his original statement and said there were three men that crawled out of the drainage ditch underneath US 281 and attempted to fight him. The male stated he struck two of the suspects while the third withdrew a box cutter. The male said he attempt to redirect the path of the blade when he received the laceration to his hand. The male said all three suspects returned to the drainage ditch and disappeared through the pipes leading underneath US 281. The suspects were described as wearing black, long-sleeve shirts and blue jeans. None appeared to be homeless by the male's account. The male's girlfriend soon arrived on scene after receiving a call for help from the male. The girlfriend informed the officer that they did have a disagreement on the phone and her boyfriend is an attention seeker. The girlfriend received a call from the male telling her he needed help because he had been cut. An inspection of the reported incident location showed no signs of a struggle. The male's knuckles did not display any markings commonly caused during a fight and the drainage pipe appeared to be impassable. The only weapon found was a knife the male had in his possession. EMS arrived on scene and treated the male's laceration by cleaning the wound and giving him a Band-Aid. The male then left the scene with his girlfriend.
