Offense: Fire Call

Time: 0739 hours

Location: 100 blk Aspen Lane

An officer was dispatched to a tree that was on fire. Upon arrival, contact was made with the homeowner who related that the SAFD had already responded but could not take any action until CPS shut off the power. The officer requested CPS to the location. The burning tree had flared up and was making contact with the power line running through the tree limbs. Due to the hazardous situation, SAFD was requested back to the scene. CPS and SAFD arrived on scene, the fire was extinguished and CPS cut the limbs from around the power lines. All responding units resumed normal service.

When the police arrived, the driver smelled of alcohol and was unsteady on her feet. Several empty beer cans were scattered through the car and one was found partially consumed. The officer did a Field Sobriety test on the female and she failed. When the officer started to handcuff her, she suddenly needed EMS although she had told the officer she was not injured in the crash. EMS transported the female to the hospital. Investigations will be filing charges on the female for Driving While Intoxicated and Driving While License Invalid.
