Offense: Burglary of a Vehicle

Date: 06.04.12

Time: 2200 hours

Location: 15700 blk San Pedro

A female called the city cell phone to report someone had smashed out her passenger side front window and had stolen two tote bags from within her car. The officer responded and contacted the female by her car. The car was parked on the west side lot of the building, near the neighboring property. All of the building's wall lights for this parking lot were not illuminated. According to the female, she had left two tote bags on the front passenger floorboard. Based on the smashed window position and the location of the bags, it appeared the suspect only reached in enough to grab the bags. The bags and their contents were stolen. The bags contained personal items and textbooks. Nothing else was stolen from the vehicle. This case is under investigation.

Officers were dispatched to a residence for a disturbance. According to the details, a female was on drugs and passed out in the street. Officers arrived and did not observe any female in the street. The officers contacted the homeowner who stated there was not a female at that location. The officer contacted the dispatcher and asked them to verify the address. The dispatcher stated the call was transferred from SAPD and the address provided to officers was incorrect. No further action taken. The officers resumed patrol.

Offense: Driving While License Invalid

Location: West Bitters Road @ West Avenue

An officer was at the intersection of West Avenue and West Bitters Road at the traffic light. The officer waited through the light cycle until the light turned green and entered the intersection, intending to turn eastbound onto West Bitters Road. As the officer was attempting to turn, a female driver ran the red traffic light traveling westbound on West Bitters Road striking the officer's patrol car. The officer and the female driver pulled into a convenience store parking lot at the intersection of West Bitters Road and West Avenue. The officer contacted the female who stated she was just learning how to drive a standard transmission and couldn't stop in time for the red light. After identifying the female, the officer did a computer check and discovered her license was invalid. The officer issued citations to the female for Disregarding Red Light, Driving While License Invalid, No Child Safety Seat, and No Insurance. The female stated she had valid insurance for the vehicle, but due to it being unconfirmed the officer issued a citation. The crash was handled by the San Antonio Police Department.
