Offense: Fire Call

Location: 100 blk Pin Oak Forest

An officer was dispatched to a Fire Alarm at a residence. The officer responded and upon arrival, made contact with the resident who stated that he had extinguished a small electrical fire coming from one of the exterior patio lights. He still wanted SAFD to respond to conduct a check. SAFD arrived on scene and determined that a bird's nest above the light had ignited. SAFD conducted a check of the interior walls and determined all to be in order. No further action was taken. Responding agencies resumed normal service.
