The investigator looked into his claim and upon reviewing the store video, the investigator observed an older female lay a newspaper down on top of his credit card and then picked up the credit card with the newspaper. According to the investigator, the female is a regular customer at the restaurant. It was learned that the credit card was used at a nearby convenience store. The convenience store has video footage of the suspect and would hold the video for police.
