Offense: Shots Fired

Officers were dispatched to Hidden View for shots fired. Officers drove around the area but did not hear any gunshots. An officer contacted the caller and asked her what happened. The caller reported hearing one gunshot at 2322 hours. Two minutes later she heard two more gunshots. Around 0020 hours she heard another gunshot and decided to call the police.

A local business owner entered city hall and requested to file a police report. The owner reported that a former employee use to be the certified public accountant for his business. The owner reported that back in 2008, he discovered discrepancies in his financial records dating back to 2002. The owner spoke with the former employee about the discrepancies and the former employee openly admitted to the owner she had taken money amounting to over \$750,000 over a period of 6 years for her own personal benefit. The owner worked with his attorney's and the former employee to resolve the issue in lieu of filing criminal charges. The former employee has stopped reimbursing the owner for the loss. The owner wanted to now press charges against the former employee for the theft of money from his business. This case is under investigation.

Offense: Forgery

A local business employee called City Hall and requested to file a Forgery report. An officer arrived and contacted the employee. The employee reported that on 07/25/2012, two unknown males passed forged company checks at a convenience store in south San Antonio. A male from the convenience store called the employee to verify that two checks that were cashed at his store were valid. The convenience store caller told the employee that he cashed two company checks made out to two separate males in the amount of \$1,100. The employee reported both checks were forged and the company had no record of either individual the checks were written to. Evidence was collected from the employee. This case is under investigation.

Offense: Burglary of a Vehicle

An officer was dispatched to a business parking lot for a burglary report. The vehicle owner reported that while she had been inside the store, an unknown person had broken into her vehicle. The suspect had punched out the driver's side door lock and entered the vehicle. Once inside, the suspect stole a purse and electronic items from inside the vehicle. The officer gathered evidence at the scene. This case is under investigation.
