Officers arrived and conducted an exterior check of the business. A storage unit was found with its door open, but officers did not see any signs of forced entry. It seemed an employee may have forgotten to close it. All appeared to be in order at that time. The male and female were not found. Officers resumed patrol.

An officer was dispatched to a local business for a suspicious person in front of the business. Upon arrival, the officer made contact with the business owner who stated that two persons from the business next door had sat in front of her business doors and were smoking a cigarette. The owner stated that due to ongoing issues with the owner from the neighboring business, she requested assistance in having them move. The owner further stated that she felt uncomfortable and frightened in dealing with anyone from the neighboring business due to several minor disagreements they have had. The officer made contact with a male and a female, who were still in the parking lot but away from the business in question. Both the male and female stated they got off work from the neighboring business and chose to stop and smoke a cigarette and realized that the location was probably going to create an issue, so they moved away on their own. They also confirmed that there were existing issues between both business owners but it had nothing to do with them smoking in front of the doors. The male and female were advised that sitting in front of the doors could create an issue and were asked to not block the doorway in the future. They both departed with no further action being taken. The officer resumed patrol.

Offense: Burglary of a Building

An officer was dispatched to a local storage business for a burglary report. Upon arrival contact was made with the renter of the unit who advised that numerous items were missing from his unit. The officer could see that there was no longer a locking mechanism attached to the roll up door. The renter said that he would take inventory of the remaining items in his unit and provide the officer with a detailed list of the missing items. While taking the initial report, the officer was contacted by the storage manager who reported that she thought she might have located the suspect vehicle on the surveillance video. The officer reviewed the video and observed that at 1423 hours, on 08/23/2012, a dark in color pickup is observed entering the gate. At 1438 hours, on the same date, the pickup exits the gate with assorted unrecognizable property in the bed. At 1513 hours, on the same date, the truck re-enters the property. At 1520 hours the truck exits the gate once again with the bed full of property. The renter was able to identify a bed and table that belonged to him, in the bed of the truck. This case is under investigation.
