she could talk in reference to their daughter. The female was in a meeting at the time of the text. The husband became upset because the female had not responded. Between 8:46 and 9:24 the ex-husband sent seven text messages to the victim's cell phone. The female texted the ex-husband and explained she had been in a meeting. At 10:02 am, the ex-husband sent an e-mail to the victim's church, as well as to two church employees, with a screen shot of the text message conversation that he and the victim were having. At approximately 1:00pm, the ex-husband called the victims office phone and the victim did not take the phone call. According to the victim, she sent her ex-husband a text message at 1:27 pm saying, "Please do not contact me at work. You have already been advised. What did you need?" Between 1:30 pm and 1:40 pm, the ex-husband called the victims work phone approximately ten times. This case is under investigation.
