Calls of Interest

Offense: Disturbance

Date: 10.25.15

Time: 1943 hours

Location: 15800 blk San Pedro

An officer received a call on the city cell phone in reference to a disturbance between a male and female at a local storage facility. The caller stated that a couple was arguing, yelling, hitting the walls and cussing. The caller also stated that she wanted to remain anonymous due to a prior confrontation with the female. The officer responded and upon arrival, could hear heavy breathing and scuffling sounds coming from inside the storage unit. The officer opened and looked into the unit and observed the male and female having sex on the storage unit floor. Both individual got dressed and stated that they did have an argument earlier but were "making up". A computer check on both subjects came back clear. While checking for identification, a driver's license, social security card, a debit card and a Sam's Card belonging to another male, were discovered in the wallet of the male subject. The 4 cards were seized and contact was made with the owner of the cards, who later responded to retrieve the items. Contact was made with the storage property manager and she was informed of the situation. The manager stated that she would like them removed from the property. Both subjects left the storage facility.

An officer observed a vehicle proceed up to a red light at the intersection of West Avenue and West Bitters Road. The operator stopped the vehicle and while the light was still red, proceeded through the intersection and travelled west on West Bitters Road. The officer followed and

activated his emergency lights, stopping the vehicle in the 500 block of Tomahawk Trail. While doing a computer check, it was discovered that she had a full extradition warrant originating out of the Cameron County Sheriff's Office. The female was detained and dispatch was contacted to verify the warrant. The dispatcher confirmed the warrant as active and valid. The female was taken into custody. The vehicle operated by the female was impounded. The female was transported and booked into the Magistrate's Office.
