Offense: Wanted Person

Date: 11.11.12

Time: 1529 hours

Location: 500 blk West Bitters Road

A vehicle was stopped after a license plate check returned unconfirmed insurance on the vehicle. The officer contacted the male driver and asked about the insurance. The male stated he thought he still had insurance, but his most recent insurance card in his vehicle expired in January 2012. The officer asked him for his license, but he only had an identification card. The driver said he did not have a license. A computer check of the identification card returned two active warrants out of the San Antonio Municipal Court. The officer had the warrants verified by dispatch. The male was then placed under arrest and secured in the back of the police car. The vehicle was inventoried by the officer. A tow truck arrived to impound the vehicle. The male was then booked into jail for the warrants.

An officer initiated a traffic stop for an expired registration and made contact with the male driver. The male was asked for his license and insurance, which he provided. being impounded. A computer check of the passenger showed him to also have warrants. The vehicle was impounded and both males were booked into jail.
