## **Calls of Interest**

### **Offense: Suspicious Vehicle**

**Date: 12.10.13**

**Time: 1445 hours**

**Location: 200 blk Tomahawk Trail**

A resident telephoned the city cellular phone to report a suspicious vehicle at her gate. The resident said her housekeeper was at the house and telephoned her saying a white pickup truck approached the front gate to the property and buzzed inside the house to get access. The resident said her housekeeper told her that a male indicated he was there to repair something in the kitchen. The housekeeper was unaware of any repair appointments and found this to be suspicious. The male was told to contact the homeowner if he wanted entry. The truck departed the location after being denied entry. The housekeeper had no other description of the vehicle other than a white pickup truck with at least one male inside. Officers checked the area, but met with negative results. Officers resumed patrol.

### **Offense: Damaged Property**

**Location: 100 blk Winding Way**

Officers were dispatched to the 200 block of Winding Way to look for a crash. The caller reported hearing what sounded like a crash. Officers checked the area and found a vehicle had gone off the road in the 100 block of Winding Way and fled the scene. Officers checked the area for the vehicle but did not find it. The first officer went back to the scene to assess the damage. It appears the vehicle was traveling eastbound when it failed to negotiate a curve in the road. The vehicle went through some vegetation in the easement, crossed a driveway, hit a trash can and came to a stop in front of a mailbox. This event caused vegetation, rocks and dirt to be spread across the driveway of a residence. The officer up righted the trash can and placed it

where it could be collected by Waste Management. The officer did not see any further damage. The officers resumed patrol.

The mother reported the male was known to fight and carry weapons. Officers arrived and found that the male had departed the location. Officers checked the area but did not find the male. The HCV officer resumed patrol. Several hours later HPPD was dispatched back to the address because the male had returned to the location. The HCV officer went to the location and found the HPPD officer talking to the male. The male was taken into custody for an Emergency Detention. The HPPD officer drove the male to the hospital and the HCV officer resumed patrol.
