Offense: Assist other Agency

Date: 01.02.13

Time: 2213 hours

Location: Winding Way @ Tower Drive

A HPPD officer notified dispatch that he was behind a stolen car. The HPPD officer was the only unit on duty at that time so a HCV officer volunteered to assist him. The HPPD officer told the dispatcher he was heading southbound on US 281 North. The HPPD officer then told the dispatcher he was turning right onto Winding Way and left onto South Tower. The HCV officer was also approaching the intersection from another direction. Once the officers were in view of each other, they both activated their lights and siren in an attempt to stop the stolen vehicle. The suspect sped away from the officers. When the stolen car approached the intersection of Bitters Road and West Avenue, it sped through the red light at full speed. The officers yielded for traffic at the intersection and continued to pursue the stolen vehicle. The stolen vehicle made a left turn onto Interpark Blvd. The officers lost sight of the vehicle and were unable to locate it again. The officers terminated the pursuit and resumed patrol.

Offense: Possession of Narcotic Paraphernalia

Location: 100 blk Marmon Ridge

An officer was patrolling a shopping center when he observed a vehicle traveling at a slow rate of speed. The vehicle then came to a complete stop in the parking lot blocking traffic. The officer ran the license plate which showed there was not a current insurance policy on the vehicle. The vehicle began moving and quickly exited the shopping center and headed

southbound on San Pedro. The officer pulled behind the vehicle when the vehicle suddenly made a right hand turn into a business parking lot. Due to the speed of the turn, the officer was unable to follow the vehicle. Due to the suspicious driving behavior as well as several traffic infractions, the officer pulled into the next business and waited for the vehicle to emerge. Several minutes later the vehicle exited the parking lot heading southbound. The officer initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle. Contact was made with the driver who told the officer that he did not have current insurance or a valid driver's license. A computer check showed the driver had a suspended license and also showed numerous arrests for narcotic violations. The officer returned to the vehicle and asked the driver if there were any narcotics in the vehicle. The driver said there were no narcotics in the vehicle and invited the officer to search the vehicle. The officer found a glass smoking pipe in a duffel bag behind the passenger. The driver told the officer that the duffel bag belonged to him but the pipe was not his property and he was unaware how it got into his bag. The driver was cited for the narcotic paraphernalia and driving on a suspended license.
