8. Citizens to be heard.

At this time, citizens who have filled out a registration form prior to the start of the meeting may speak on any topic they wish to bring to the attention of the governing body so long as that topic is not on the agenda for this meeting. Citizens may speak on specific agenda items when that item is called for discussion. During the Citizens to be Heard section no council action may take place and no council discussion or response is required to the speaker. A time limit of two minutes per speaker is permitted; the council may extend this time at their discretion.

Discussion and possible action regarding readopting ordinance 812, establishing a curfew for minors under seventeen years of age to prohibit being in a public place between the hours of midnight and 6:00 a.m.; providing an enforcement procedure; establishing criminal penalties for the minors and for parents of minors and adopting certain exceptions.
- 10. Discussion and possible action establishing guidelines for reappointments for the City of Hill Country Village Zoning Commission, Board of Adjustment, Economic Development Corporation and the Business District Construction Review Board.
- 11. Discussion and possible action prohibiting the use of a hand-held device to engage in a call, or send, read or write a text message, or engage in any other use of the device while operating a moving vehicle; and providing for a fine of up to \$200.00 per violation.
- 12. Discussion and possible action on a report from a committee on their findings and recommendations on the two proposals received regarding the Request for Qualifications for the Bitters Road Property.
